

Vermont State Record Fish Entry Form RULES:



- ▼ A department fisheries biologist <u>must inspect</u> the fish. The fish must be fresh or frozen when inspected. Mounted fish will not do.
- ➡ All forms must be accompanied by a clear photograph of the fish, side view, preferably including the angler. See back of card for eligible fish species. Entry form and photo must be submitted within six months of the date of capture.
