Landowner Permission

for Field Trials, Dog Training, Live-Trapping Rabbit/Hare

Field Trials: Pursuant to 10 V.S.A. § 5002 the Vermont Fish & Wildlife Department may authorize organized groups to hold field trials for hunting dogs on properties with landowner approval.

Live-Trapping: Pursuant to 10 V.S.A. App. §32 (Trapping hare and rabbits) the Vermont Fish & Wildlife Department may authorize a beagle club, or a private owner of an enclosed area of not less than 20 acres in size, to take live snowshoe hare and cottontail rabbits. Prior to setting any trap, the permit holder must obtain written permission from the property owner(s) where traps are to be set. Signed permission forms must be submitted with the permit application.
