We gratefully accept your offer to volunteer your services to the State of Vermont as permitted under 3 V.S.A § 207(b.)

You will report to Nicole Meier who will supervise your work in connection with the Vermont Hunter Education Program. The period of volunteer services covered by this document will be from January 1st 20__ to December 31st 20__. This agreement is only valid for one year from date of acceptance by the volunteer. The consideration for such services is education, training, and experience.

Subject to the approval of the Department of Fish & Wildlife, you may be reimbursed for necessary incidental expenses such as transportation, overnight lodging, and subsistence when such expense has been incurred during approved, work- related travel.

For the purposes of Vermont law 3 V.S.A. § 110 1 (b) (4) and 12 V.S.A. §§ 5601-5606, you will be considered a State employee. However, you will not be deemed a State employee and shall not be subject to the provision of law relating to State employment and collective bargaining agreements relating to hours of work, rate of compensation, leave, and State employee benefits. The State of Vermont and the Volunteer reserve the right to cancel this agreement at any time upon mutual agreement or reasonable justification.
