## **CAMP RULES**

- 1. Campers are expected to be courteous, kind, and respectful to themselves, their peers, and their instructors.
- 2. Campers may not leave camp area except with an instructor, parent, or guardian.
- 3. Swimming shall only be at scheduled times and under supervision.
- 4. Smoking and/or possession of any substance by campers is prohibited.
- 5. Profane, obscene, or abusive language is prohibited.
- 6. Abuse of camp property or equipment is prohibited.
- 7. Campers are expected to attend all scheduled activities and to abide by all other Rules of Conduct explained to them at camp.

Infractions of these rules or continued misbehavior will be considered just cause for dismissal from camp with <u>no refund</u>.
