It is recommended that all clothing/equipment is marked with the camper's name or initials to aid staff in returning lost items.

CAMP RULES

- 7. Campers are expected to attend all scheduled activities and to abide by all other Rules of Conduct explained to them at camp.

Infractions of these rules or continued misbehavior will be considered just cause for dismissal from camp with <u>no refund</u> and <u>non-certification</u> in Hunter Education.
