Looks for the Sights and Sounds of Birds

Spring is a great time to hear the loud gobble of the male, tom turkey! Find out more about this amazing animal, and how to search for its signs in the woods here.

Learn the calls of three common birds near your home. Listen to audio recordings from the Cornell's All About Birds <u>website</u> to help you learn the names and calls of the birds.

Search the trees for bird nests – but do not touch them! Before trees and shrubs leaf out is a great time to see nests that survived the winter winds and snow. Bring a pencil and sketchpad with you so you can record what you find! Different bird species create different types of nests depending on their specific needs and behaviors. Try your hand at some of the knots these natural weavers create with their beaks!
