Yellow Perch	None	50	Angling, ice fishing	2 <sup>nd</sup> Saturday in April to Oct 31 and 3 <sup>rd</sup> Saturday in Jan. to March 15
Chain Pickerel, Bullhead, Rock Bass, Pumpkinseed	None	None	Angling, ice fishing	2 <sup>nd</sup> Saturday in April to Oct 31 and 3 <sup>rd</sup> Saturday in Jan. to March 15
