**Certified Birth Certificate required:**

Please send a COPY of a **certified** birth certificate, not the original.

**Proof of residency required for Vermont applicants only:**

**10 VSA 4279:** A resident is a person who has resided in Vermont for the 12 months immediately prior to making application for the license and who has not claimed residency in any other state or country for any reason.

**For a child, the parent or legal guardian of the child must show proof of Vermont residency; if legal guardian, guardian proof must also be provided.**

**Two separate proofs of residency are required. Acceptable proofs of residency are:**

- Copy of two most recent years of tax returns (page 1 only) – will satisfy proof of residency.
- Copy of two most recent years of W2's – will satisfy proof of residency.
- A voter registration card or a letter from Town Clerk **along with one additional proof** – will satisfy proof of residency.
- Copies of previous 12 months of utility bills, bank statements, or the like, **along with one additional proof** – will satisfy proof of residency.

*Confidential material may be blanked out; Parent name and address must be shown.*

**Issuing of License:**

**To qualify for a fishing license:**

Submit a letter requesting a fishing license just before the child's 15<sup>th</sup> birthday.

A new Sporting License Application must also be completed and submitted with paperwork

**To qualify for a hunting or a combination hunting and fishing license:**

Submit a copy of a previous hunting license or a hunter education card from any state.

A new Sporting License Application must also be completed and submitted with paperwork

**Proof of hunter education requirement for a child:**

For a combination hunting and fishing license for a child, the hunting license will not be issued until the child passes a hunter education course. If the child is 15 or older, a fishing license can be issued prior to passing a hunter education course, by submitting a letter requesting a fishing license.
